Amends the Illinois  $\mbox{Act}$  on the Aging. Makes a technical change in a Section creating the Department on Aging.

1 AN ACT concerning State government.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Act on the Aging is amended by changing Section 4 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 105/4) (from Ch. 23, par. 6104)
- 7 Sec. 4. There is created the the Department on Aging. The 8 Director of the Department on Aging, in conjunction with the 9 Director of the Department of Public Aid shall prepare and 10 implement a plan to transfer all personnel, materials, books, records, appropriations and equipment related to "Services to 11 Older People" in the Department of Public Aid as described in 12 Article VIII of, "The Illinois Public Aid Code", to the 13 14 Department on Aging by the effective date of this Act. The Department on Aging shall administer programs related to 15 16 "Services to Older People", described in Article VIII of, "The 17 Illinois Public Aid Code", on the effective date of this Act.
- Upon the effective date of this Act, the Department on Aging shall be the single State agency for receiving and disbursing federal funds made available under the "Older Americans Act".
