1 AN ACT concerning safety.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,

represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Environmental Protection Act is amended by
- 5 changing Section 9.2 as follows:
- 6 (415 ILCS 5/9.2) (from Ch. 111 1/2, par. 1009.2)
- 7 Sec. 9.2. Sulfur dioxide emission standards.
- 8 (a) (Blank.)
- 9 (b) In granting any alternative emission standard or
- 10 variance relating to sulfur dioxide emissions from a
- 11 coal-burning stationary source, the the Board may require the
- 12 use of Illinois coal as a condition of such alternative
- 13 standard or variance, provided that the Board determines that
- 14 Illinois coal of the proper quality is available and
- 15 competitive in price; such determination shall include
- 16 consideration of the cost of pollution control equipment and
- 17 the economic impact on the Illinois coal mining industry.
