- 4 Section 5. The Circuit Courts Act is amended by changing
- 5 Section 4 as follows:
- 6 (705 ILCS 35/4) (from Ch. 37, par. 72.4)
- 7 Sec. 4. There shall be no stated terms in the the circuit
- 8 courts, which shall always be open for the transaction of all
- 9 business, subject to adjournment from time to time. The circuit
- 10 judges in each circuit shall prescribe by rule the times of
- 11 calling grand and petit juries in each of the counties of the
- 12 circuit and the periods for which the jurors shall serve.
