1 AN ACT concerning business.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Agricultural Co-Operative Act is amended by changing Section 1 as follows:
- 6 (805 ILCS 315/1) (from Ch. 32, par. 440)
- 7 Sec. 1. In order to promote, foster and and encourage the intelligent and orderly marketing of agricultural products 8 through co-operation; to eliminate speculation and waste; to 9 10 the distribution of agricultural products between producer and consumer as direct as can be efficiently done; to 11 stabilize the marketing of agricultural products, and to 12 provide for the organization and incorporation of agricultural 13 14 co-operative associations and societies, this Act is passed.
