2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Interest Act is amended by changing Section
4b as follows:

6 (815 ILCS 205/4b) (from Ch. 17, par. 6411)

Sec. 4b. In order to assure compliance with applicable Federal law, any State agency having chartering or licensing powers or regulatory or supervisory authority over a class of creditors affected by this Act may promulgate rules <u>and</u> and regulations to carry out the disclosure and other requirements pertaining to the extension of credit under this Act and the advertising of such extensions of credit.
