

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

17 Section 510. The amount of \$2,000,000, or so much  
18 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the

2     thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the FY 09  
3     Budget Relief Fund to the Department of Agriculture for  
4     distribution of institutional agricultural research grants to  
5     public universities authorized by the Food and Agriculture  
6     Research Act to include administrative costs incurred by the
