13 Section 10. The sum of \$1,650,000, or so much thereof as
 14 is available for use by the Attorney General, is appropriated
 15 to the Attorney General from the Illinois Gaming Law
 16 Enforcement Fund for State law enforcement purposes.

17 Section 15. The following named sums, or so much thereof
 18 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated from the
 19 Asbestos Abatement Fund to the Attorney General to meet the
 20 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Environmental
 21 Enforcement-Asbestos Litigation Division:

12 Section 20. The amount of \$5,500,000, or so much thereof
13 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney
14 General Court Ordered and Voluntary Compliance Payment
15 Projects Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for use,
16 subject to pertinent court order or agreement, in the
17 performance of any function pertaining to the exercise of the
18 duties of the Attorney General, including State law
19 enforcement and public education.

20 Section 25. The amount of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof
21 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois
22 Charity Bureau Fund to the Office of the Attorney General to
23 enforce the provisions of the Solicitation for Charity Act

1 and to gather and disseminate information about charitable
2 trustees and organizations to the public.

3 Section 30. The amount of \$2,550,000, or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney
5 General Whistleblower Reward and Protection Fund to the
6 Office of the Attorney General for State law enforcement
7 purposes.

8 Section 35. The amount of \$900,000, or so much thereof
9 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
10 Litigation Trust Fund to the Attorney General for financial
11 support under the Capital Crimes Litigation Act.

12 Section 40. The amount of \$1,050,000, or so much thereof
13 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Tobacco
14 Settlement Recovery Fund to the Attorney General for the
15 funding of a unit responsible for oversight, enforcement, and
16 implementation of the Master Settlement Agreement entered in
17 the case of People of the State of Illinois v. Philip Morris,
18 et al. (Circuit Court of Cook County, No. 96L13146), for
19 enforcement of the Tobacco Product Manufacturers' Escrow Act,
20 and for handling remaining tobacco-related litigation.

21 Section 45. The amount of \$3,600,000, or so much thereof

1 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney
 2 General's State Projects and Court Ordered Distribution Fund
 3 to the Attorney General for payment of interagency
 4 agreements, for court-ordered distributions to third parties,
 5 and, subject to pertinent court order, for performance of any
 6 function pertaining to the exercise of the duties of the
 7 Attorney General, including State law enforcement and public
 8 education.

9 Section 50. The amount of \$5,000, or so much thereof as
 10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney General's
 11 Grant Fund to the Office of the Attorney General to be
 12 expended in accordance with the terms and conditions upon
 13 which those funds were received.

14 Section 55. The following named amounts, or so much
 15 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
 16 and purposes named in this Section, are appropriated to the
 17 Attorney General to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses
 18 of the Attorney General:

12 Section 60. The amount of \$320,000, or so much thereof
13 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Child Support
14 Administrative Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for
15 child support enforcement purposes.

16 Section 65. The amount of \$2,050,000, or so much thereof
17 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney
18 General Federal Grant Fund to the Office of the Attorney
19 General for funding for federal grants.

20 Section 70. The amount of \$500,000, or so much thereof
21 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Sex Offender
22 Management Board Fund to the Sex Offender Management Board

1 for the purposes authorized by the Sex Offender Management
2 Board Act including, but not limited to, sex offender
3 evaluation, treatment, and monitoring programs and grants.
4 Funding received from private sources is to be expended in
5 accordance with the terms and conditions placed upon the
6 funding.

7 Section 75. The amount of \$50,000, or so much thereof as
8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Statewide Grand
9 Jury Prosecution Fund to the Office of the Attorney General
10 for expenses incurred in criminal prosecutions arising under
11 the Statewide Grand Jury Act.

12 Section 80. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof as
13 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
14 Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for disbursement
15 to the Illinois Equal Justice Foundation in accordance with
16 the terms of Section 25 of the Illinois Equal Justice Act.".

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
