### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/10-20.40 new 30 ILCS 805/8.31 new

Amends the School Code. Requires a school board (other than the Chicago Board of Education) to adopt a dress code policy to apply to students beginning with the 2007-2008 school year. Amends the State Mandates Act to require implementation without reimbursement. Effective immediately.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section
10-20.40 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/10-20.40 new)

Sec. 10-20.40. Dress code required. Each school board shall adopt a dress code policy to apply to students beginning with the 2007-2008 school year.

Section 90. The State Mandates Act is amended by adding Section 8.31 as follows:

12 (30 ILCS 805/8.31 new) 13 <u>Sec. 8.31. Exempt mandate. Notwithstanding Sections 6 and 8</u> 14 <u>of this Act, no reimbursement by the State is required for the</u> 15 <u>implementation of any mandate created by this amendatory Act of</u>

16 the 95th General Assembly.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect uponbecoming law.
