AN ACT concerning appropriations.

# Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The amount of \$350,000, or so much of that 5 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General 6 Revenue Fund to the Juvenile Defender Resource Center for the 7 employment of 3 attorneys, one responsible for training, and 8 2 other attorneys to travel the circuits to provide legal 9 advice and to identify expert witnesses in serious felony 10 cases and for training expenses, travel, and office expenses.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2007.
