

1 AN ACT concerning criminal law.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Criminal Identification Act is amended by  
5 adding Section 9.5 as follows:

6 (20 ILCS 2630/9.5 new)

7 Sec. 9.5. Material for DNA fingerprint analysis. Every  
8 county medical examiner and coroner shall provide to the  
9 Department a sample of saliva or tissue from a dead body for  
10 DNA fingerprint analysis if the Department notifies the medical  
11 examiner or coroner that the Department has determined that  
12 providing that sample may be useful for law enforcement  
13 purposes in a criminal investigation. In addition, if a local  
14 law enforcement agency notifies a county medical examiner or  
15 coroner that such a sample would be useful in a criminal  
16 examination, the county medical examiner or coroner shall  
17 provide a sample to both the Department and the local law  
18 enforcement agency.
