## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Business Corporation Act of 1983 is amended by adding Section 12.43 as follows:

- 14 <u>the date of issuance of the certificate of dissolution, the</u>
- domestic corporation shall continue under its previous name
- 16 <u>without impacting its continuous legal status</u>, unless the
- corporation petitions to change its name upon reinstatement.
- 18 Section 10. The General Not For Profit Corporation Act of
- 19 1986 is amended by adding Section 112.43 as follows:
- 20 (805 ILCS 105/112.43 new)
- 21 Sec. 112.43. Administrative dissolution; corporate name.

- 1 The Secretary of State shall not allow another corporation to use the name of a domestic corporation that has been 2 administratively dissolved until 3 years have elapsed 3 following the date of issuance of the certificate of 4 dissolution. If the <u>domestic corporation that has been</u> 5 6 administratively dissolved is reinstated within 3 years after the date of issuance of the certificate of dissolution, the 7 domestic corporation shall continue under its previous name 8 9 without impacting its continuous legal status, unless the 10 corporation petitions to change its name upon reinstatement.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 11 12 becoming law.
