SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 3105/20 new

Amends the Capital Development Board Act. Requires that the Board make a good faith effort to increase to 20% its average percentage of project funding that is directed to minority-owned and female-owned businesses. Effective immediately.

- 7 Sec. 20. Minority-owned and female-owned businesses. The
- 8 Board shall make a good faith effort to increase to 20% its
- 9 average percentage of project funding directed to
- 10 minority-owned businesses and female-owned businesses, as
- 11 <u>those terms are defined in the Business Enterprise for</u>
- 12 Minorities, Females, and Persons with Disabilities Act.
- 13 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 14 becoming law.
