## 7 Sec. 3-664. Iraq Campaign license plates.

(a) In addition to any other special license plate, the 8 9 Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and applications 10 made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State, may issue Iraq Campaign license plates to residents of Illinois who 11 12 have earned the Iraq Campaign Medal from the United States Armed Forces. The special Iraq Campaign plates issued under 13 14 this Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division, motorcycles, and motor vehicles of the second 15 16 division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates issued 17 under this Section shall expire according to the staggered multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of this 18 19 Code.

(b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall be 20 wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State. The 21 22 Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be issued as vanity plates or personalized in accordance with 23

Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are not required to 1 designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) of 2 Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary shall, in his or her 5 6 discretion, approve and prescribe stickers or decals as 7 provided under Section 3-412. (c) An applicant shall be charged a \$15 fee for original 8 9 issuance in addition to the applicable registration fee. This 10 additional fee shall be deposited into the Secretary of State 11 Special License Plate Fund.
