- 7 <u>Sec. 3-664. Iraq Campaign license plates.</u>
- (a) In addition to any other special license plate, the 8 Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and applications 10 made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State, may issue Iraq Campaign license plates to residents of Illinois who 11 12 have earned the Iraq Campaign Medal from the United States Armed Forces. The special Iraq Campaign plates issued under 13 14 this Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division, motorcycles, and motor vehicles of the second 15 16 division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates issued 17 under this Section shall expire according to the staggered multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of this 18 19 Code.
  - (b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall be wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State. The Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be issued as vanity plates or personalized in accordance with

- designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) of

- 16 Illinois who have earned the Afghanistan Campaign Medal from
- 17 the United States Armed Forces. The special Afghanistan

- 19 to passenger vehicles of the first division, motorcycles, and
- 20 motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than
