Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Barber, Cosmetology, Esthetics, and Nail
- 5 Technology Act of 1985 is amended by changing Section 4-8 as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (225 ILCS 410/4-8) (from Ch. 111, par. 1704-8)
- 8 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2016)
- 9 Sec. 4-8. Persons in need of mental treatment. The The
- 10 determination by a circuit court that a licensee is subject to
- involuntary admission or judicial admission as provided in the
- 12 Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities Code operates as
- an automatic suspension. Such suspension shall end only upon a
- 14 finding by a court that the patient is no longer subject to
- involuntary admission or judicial admission and issues an order
- 16 so finding and discharging the patient; and upon the
- 17 recommendation of the Committee to the Director that the
- 18 licensee be allowed to resume his practice.
