1	AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 1699
2	AMENDMENT NO Amend Senate Bill 1699 by replacing
3	everything after the enacting clause with the following:
4	"Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
5	Purchase of Care and Grant Adjustment Act.
6	Section 5. Definitions. As used in this Act:
7	"Purchase of care contract" means a contract between a
8	State officer or agency and a private provider under which
9	rates for services are set in accordance with a formula that
10	takes personnel, supplies, and other allowable costs into
11	account.
12	"Grant" has the meaning ascribed to that term in the
13	Illinois Procurement Code.

Section 10. Applicability. This Act applies to all

purchase of care contracts, grant agreements, and provider

- 1 agreements that (i) provide in whole or in part for the 2 provision of services for persons with disabilities or (ii) are entered into between the Department of Children and Family 3 4 Services, the Department of Human Services, the Department of 5 Corrections, the Department of Public Health, the Department of 6 Commerce and Economic Opportunity, or the Department of Healthcare and Family Services and a private community-based 7 8 contractual provider or grantee.
- 9 Section 15. Adjustments. Notwithstanding any other 10 provision of law, purchase of care contracts and grant agreements to which this Act applies must provide for annual 11 12 adjustments in accordance with the non-seasonally-adjusted Employment Cost Index for total compensation for civilian 13 14 workers compiled by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect January 15 1, 2008.". 16
