registration of one <u>motor vehicle of the first division or one</u> <u>motor vehicle of the second division weighing not more than</u> <u>8,000 pounds of those vehicles</u>, to the Secretary of State without the payment of any registration fee. Registration shall be for a multi-year period and may be issued staggered registration.

(b) (Blank). Any disabled veteran of World War I, of World 7 War II, of the National Emergency between June 25, 1950 and 8 9 January 31, 1955 or of the period beginning February 1, 1955 10 and ending on the day before the first day thereafter in which individuals (other than individuals liable for induction by 11 reason of prior deferment) are no longer liable for induction 12 13 for training and service into the armed forces under the Military Selective Service Act of 1967, or of any armed 14 15 conflict involving the armed forces of the United States, who 16 has a service connected disability of such a nature that it would, if it had been incurred in World War II, have entitled 17 him to be awarded an automobile by the United States Federal 18 19 Government, or who is receiving compensation from the Veterans 20 Administration for total service-connected disability, may 21 make application to the Secretary of State for the registration 22 of one motor vehicle of the first division without accompanying 23 his or her application with the payment of any fee.

(c) Renewal of this registration must be accompanied with
documentation for eligibility of registration without fee
unless the applicant has a permanent qualifying disability, and

1 these registration plates may not be issued to any person not 2 eligible to receive them.

3 (d) The Illinois Veterans Commission may assist in4 providing the documentation of disability.
