Introduced 10/2/2007, by Sen. M. Maggie Crotty

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates \$64,200,000 from the General Revenue Fund to the Department on Aging for vendors of homemaker, chore, and housekeeping services to increase the wages paid to employees who provide homemaker, chore, and housekeeping services and to provide health insurance coverage to those employees and their dependents. Effective immediately.

BUDGET NOTE
ACT MAY APPLY

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The sum of \$64,200,000, or so much of that
5 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
6 Revenue Fund to the Department on Aging for funding the
7 following:

8 (1) an additional \$1.70 per hour to be paid to vendors of
9 homemaker, chore, and housekeeping services for the purpose
10 of increasing, by at least \$1.00 per hour, the wages paid by
11 those vendors to their employees who provide homemaker,
12 chore, and housekeeping services, in order to adjust for the
13 statewide minimum wage increase; and

14 (2) an additional \$1.33 per hour to be paid to vendors of
15 homemaker, chore, and housekeeping services for the purpose
16 of providing health insurance coverage to their employees who
17 provide homemaker, chore, and housekeeping services and to
18 those employees' dependents.

19 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
20 becoming law.
