## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Amends "An Act making appropriations", Public Act 95-348, if and only if certain appropriations to the Supreme Court in that Public Act that were reduced by the Governor are not restored to their original amounts. Increases those appropriations to their original amounts. Effective immediately.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

"An Act making appropriations", Public Act 4 95-348, approved with items vetoed and reduced on August 23, 5 2007, is amended, if and only if the items in Sections 20, 6 25, and 30 of Article 150 of Public Act 95-348 that were 7 reduced by the Governor are not restored to their original 8 9 amounts, by changing Sections 20, 25, and 30 of Article 150 as follows: 10 (P.A. 95-348, Article 150, Sec. 20) 11 Sec. 20.
