1 AN ACT concerning public aid.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by adding Section 5-2.08 as follows:
- 6 (305 ILCS 5/5-2.08 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 5-2.08. Spousal caregiver demonstration.</u>
- (a) The Department of Human Services, in consultation with
 the Department of Healthcare and Family Services, shall develop
 a demonstration project within the Home Services Program under
 which a spouse may be reimbursed for providing care to his or
 her spouse, who is eligible for services through the Home
 Services Program and who meets the criteria for this
 demonstration project. The demonstration project shall operate
- in selected counties and be limited to serving no more than 100
- unduplicated persons in a State fiscal year.
- The components of the demonstration project shall include
 the following:
- (1) Authorization for a spouse to be reimbursed for

 20 care provided to his or her otherwise eligible spouse

 21 through the Home Services Program.
- 22 (2) The development of specific criteria for the provision of services under the demonstration project.

| 22 | (b) By July 1, 2008, the Department of Human Services, in |
| 23 | consultation with the Department of Healthcare and Family |
| 24 | Services, shall begin development of the demonstration |
| 25 | project. The Department of Human Services shall provide an |
| 26 | interim report on or before March 1, 2009 to the Governor and |

- development of the demonstration project and implementation 2
- 3 timelines of the demonstration project and the criteria for the

- 5 (c) The Department of Human Services shall report findings
- 6 and recommendations by March 1, 2010 to the Governor and the
- 7 General Assembly. The report shall include an explanation of
- 8 the manner in which each demonstration project component listed
- 9 in paragraphs (1) through (10) of subsection (a) is addressed.
- 10 In addition, the report shall include (i) the estimated number
- 11 of clients statewide who could utilize services and (ii) an
- 12 analysis of the fiscal impact per client on the Department's
- 13 new and existing costs under the Home Services Program.
- 14 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- becoming law. 15
