A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Article 1

5 Section 1. "An Act making appropriations," Public Act 95-
6 348, as vetoed, reduced, and restored, is amended by changing
7 Section 40 of Article 185, as follows:

8 (P.A. 95-348, Art, 185, Sec. 40)

9 Sec. 40. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
10 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the
11 Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity:

12 BUREAU OF WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

13 GRANTS-IN-AID

14 Payable from the General Revenue Fund:

15 For grants to community non-profit
16 agencies or organizations for the
17 operation of a statewide network of
18 outreach services for veterans, as
19 provided for in the Veteran's
20 Employment Act769,400

21 For Grants, Contracts and Administrative

1 Expenses associated with the Employment
 2 Opportunities Grant Program pursuant
 3 to 20 ILCS 605/605-812, including
 4 prior year costs6,250,000
 5 For Grants, Contracts and Administrative
 6 Expenses Pursuant to the Job Training
 7 And Economic Development Grant Program
 8 Act of 1997, as amended1,392,000
 9 Total \$8,411,400

10 Payable from the Federal Workforce Training Fund:

11 For Grants, Contracts and Administrative
 12 Expenses Associated with the Workforce
 13 Investment Act and other workforce
 14 training programs, including refunds
 15 and prior year costs273,000,000 ~~275,000,000~~

16 In addition to any other funds
 17 appropriated to the Local Workforce
 18 Investment Area 15, a grant to the
 19 City of Peoria for the Central Illinois
 20 Workforce Development Board
 21 to support the Talent Force 21
 22 regional workforce development initiative2,000,000

23 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
 24 becoming law.
