Amends the Smoke Free Illinois Act. Provides that any person who registers a complaint under the Act must disclose his or her name. Effective immediately.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,

represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Smoke Free Illinois Act is amended by
- 5 changing Section 40 as follows:
- 6 (410 ILCS 82/40)
- 7 Sec. 40. Enforcement; complaints.
- 8 (a) The Department, State-certified local public health
- 9 departments, and local law enforcement agencies shall enforce
- 10 the provisions of this Act and may assess fines pursuant to
- 11 Section 45 of this Act.
- 12 (b) Any person may register a complaint with the
- Department, a State-certified local public health department,
- or a local law enforcement agency for a violation of this Act.
- 15 A person must disclose his or her name when registering a
- 16 <u>complaint.</u> The Department shall establish a telephone number
- 17 that a person may call to register a complaint under this
- 18 subsection (b).
