Amends the Illinois Municipal Code. Provides that the corporate authorities may license, tax, and regulate, among others, bankers "other than financial institutions". Effective immediately.

- Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by
- 5 changing Section 11-42-1 as follows:
- 6 (65 ILCS 5/11-42-1) (from Ch. 24, par. 11-42-1)
- 7 Sec. 11-42-1. The corporate authorities of each
- 8 municipality may license, tax, and regulate auctioneers,
- 9 private detectives, demolition contractors, money changers,
- 10 bankers other than financial institutions, brokers other than
- insurance brokers, barbers, and the keepers or owners of lumber
- 12 yards, lumber storehouses, livery stables, public scales, ice
- 13 cream parlors, coffee houses, florists, detective agencies,
- 14 barber shops and sellers of tickets for theatricals, shows,
- amusements, athletic events and other exhibitions at a place
- other than the theatre or location where the theatricals,
- shows, amusements, athletic events and other exhibitions are
- 18 given or exhibited.
