

## 95TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2007 and 2008 SB2361

Introduced 2/14/2008, by Sen. Dan Cronin

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 505/12

from Ch. 23, par. 5012

Amends the Children and Family Services Act. Provides that the Department of Children and Family Services shall work with representatives of voluntary foster care providers and foster parents to determine rates to be paid to foster parents of wards of the State for State fiscal year 2009 that will equitably distribute moneys appropriated to the Department to fund an increase in the cost of care reimbursement rate for foster parents according to a national methodology such as the Foster Care MARC (Minimum Adequate Rates for Children) developed by the Children's Rights/National Foster Parent Association and the University of Maryland School of Social Work. Requires the Department to work with such representatives to establish a methodology for calculating foster caregiver reimbursement rates. Requires the Department to adopt rules for the development and review of the methodology no later than January 1, 2009. Effective July 1, 2008.

FISCAL NOTE ACT

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Children and Family Services Act is amended by changing Section 12 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 505/12) (from Ch. 23, par. 5012)
- 7 12. (a) provide To supervision, 8 accommodations, board or the payment of boarding costs, 9 tuition, and treatment free of charge, except as otherwise specified in this Act, for residents of this State who are 10 cared for in any institution, or for persons receiving services 11 under any program under the jurisdiction of the Department. 12 13 Residents of other states may be admitted upon payment of the 14 costs of board, tuition, and treatment as determined by the Department; provided, that no resident of another state shall 15 16 be received or retained to the exclusion of any resident of 17 this State. The Department shall accept any donation for the board, tuition, and treatment of any person receiving service 18 19 or care.
  - (b) By July 1, 1994, to make room and board payments to persons providing foster care under this Act at a rate for each child that is up to 100% of the adjusted United States
