The trier of fact may infer It shall be prima 8 9 facie evidence that a person intends to deprive the owner permanently of the use or benefit of the property "knowingly 10 obtains or exerts unauthorized control over property of the 11 12 owner" (1) if a lessee of the personal property of another fails to return it to the owner within 10 days after written 13 14 demand from the owner for its return or (2) if a lessee of the personal property of another fails to return it to the owner 15 16 within 24 hours after written demand from the owner for its 17 return and the lessee had presented identification to the owner that contained a materially fictitious name, address, or 18 telephone number. A notice in writing, given after the 19 20 expiration of the leasing agreement, addressed and mailed, by 21 registered mail, to the lessee at the address given by him and 22 shown on the leasing agreement shall constitute proper demand.
