SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

10 ILCS 5/9-28

Amends the Election Code. Requires that the State Board of Elections' searchable electronic database of campaign contribution reports must be searchable by employer and occupation of the contributor with respect to contributions for which that information is reported. Effective immediately.

AN ACT concerning elections.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Election Code is amended by changing Section
9-28 as follows:

6 (10 ILCS 5/9-28)

Sec. 9-28. Electronic filing and availability. The Board shall by rule provide for the electronic filing of expenditure and contribution reports as follows:

Beginning July 1, 1999, or as soon thereafter as the Board has provided adequate software to the political committee, electronic filing is required for all political committees that during the reporting period (i) had at any time a balance or an accumulation of contributions of \$25,000 or more, (ii) made aggregate expenditures of \$25,000 or more, or (iii) received loans of an aggregate of \$25,000 or more.

Beginning July 1, 2003, electronic filing is required for all political committees that during the reporting period (i) had at any time a balance or an accumulation of contributions of \$10,000 or more, (ii) made aggregate expenditures of \$10,000 or more, or (iii) received loans of an aggregate of \$10,000 or more.

The Board may provide by rule for the optional electronic

filing of expenditure and contribution reports for all other political committees. The Board shall promptly make all reports filed under this Article by all political committees publicly available by means of a searchable database that is accessible through the World Wide Web. <u>The database must be searchable by</u> <u>employer and occupation of contributor, with respect to those</u> contributions for which that information is reported.

8 The Board shall provide all software necessary to comply 9 with this Section to candidates, public officials, political 10 committees, and election authorities.

11 The Board shall implement a plan to provide computer access 12 and assistance to candidates, public officials, political 13 committees, and election authorities with respect to 14 electronic filings required under this Article.

For the purposes of this Section, "political committees" includes entities required to report to the Board under Section 9-7.5.
