1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

ARTICLE 1

6 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
7 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
8 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the
9 General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community College Board
10 for ordinary and contingent expenses:

12	For State Contributions to Social	
13	Security, for Medicare	15,500
14	For Contractual Services	325,200
15	For Travel	56,500
16	For Commodities	7,500

1 Section 10. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof as
 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Community
 3 College Board Contracts and Grants Fund to the Illinois
 4 Community College Board to be expended under the terms and
 5 conditions associated with the moneys being received.

6 Section 15. The sum of \$1,500,000, or so much thereof as
 7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the ICCB Adult
 8 Education Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for
 9 operational expenses associated with administration of adult
 10 education and literacy activities.

11 Section 20. The following named amounts, or so much
 12 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
 13 from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community
 14 College Board for distribution to qualifying public community
 15 colleges for the purposes specified:

1 Section 25. The sum of \$1,589,100, or so much thereof as
 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
 3 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for grants to
 4 operate an educational facility in the former community
 5 college district #541 in East St. Louis.

6 Section 30. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as
 7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the AFDC Opportunities
 8 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for grants to
 9 colleges for workforce training and technology and operating
 10 costs of the Board for those purposes.

11 Section 35. The following named amounts, or so much of
 12 those amounts as may be necessary, for the objects and
 13 purposes named, are appropriated to the Illinois Community
 14 College Board for adult education and literacy activities:

22 Section 35. The following named amounts, or so much
23 thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois
24 Community College Board for all costs associated with career

1 and technical education activities:

2 From the General Revenue Fund..... 12,149,900

3 From the Career and Technical Education Fund.....23,607,100

4 Total, this Section \$35,757,000

5 Section 40. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as

6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the ICCB Federal Trust

7 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for ordinary and

8 contingency expenses of the Board.

9 Section 45. The sum of \$15,000,000, or so much thereof

10 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue

11 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for the City

12 Colleges of Chicago for educational-related expenses.

13 Section 50. The sum of \$120,100, or so much thereof as

14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue

15 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for awarding

16 scholarships to qualifying graduates of the Lincoln's

17 Challenge Program.

18 Section 55. The sum of \$807,600, or so much thereof as

19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue

20 Fund to Illinois Community College Board for costs associated

21 with administering GED tests.

1 Section 60. The sum of \$750,000, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the ISBE GED Testing
3 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for costs
4 associated with administering GED tests.

5 Section 65. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from ICCB Instruction
7 Development and Enhancement Applications Revolving Fund to
8 the Illinois Community College Board for costs associated
9 with maintaining and updating instructional technology.

10 Section 70. The sum of \$170,000, or so much thereof as
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
12 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for costs and
13 expenses related to or in support of a higher education
14 shared services center.

15 Section 75. The sum of \$115,000, or so much thereof as
16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the ICCB Federal Trust
17 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for costs and
18 expenses related to or in support of a higher education
19 shared services center.

 Section 80. The sum of \$7,261,500, or so much thereof as

may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community College Board to reimburse colleges up to 50 percent of the costs associated with the Illinois Veterans' Grant.

1 Section 85. The sum of \$750,000, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
3 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for costs
4 associated with the College and Career Readiness Pilot
5 Program.

6 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July
7 1, 2008.
