A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the
8 General Revenue Fund to meet the ordinary and contingent
9 expenses of the Deaf and Hard of Hearing Commission:

11	For State Contributions to State	
12	Employees' Retirement System	80,900
13	For State Contributions to

15	For Contractual Services	94,900

3 Section 10. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as
4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Interpreters for
5 the Deaf Fund to the Deaf and Hard of Hearing Commission for
6 administration and enforcement of the Interpreter for the
7 Deaf Licensure Act of 2007.

8 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July
9 1, 2008.
