Makes appropriations to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for its ordinary and contingent expenses. Makes appropriations to the Office of the State Appellate Defender from specified funds. Effective July 1, 2008.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much of  
5 those amounts as may be necessary, respectively, for the  
6 objects and purposes named, are appropriated from the General  
7 Revenue Fund to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of  
8 the Office of the State Appellate Defender:

 2 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Office of  
 3 the State Appellate Defender for the ordinary and contingent  
 4 expenses of the Post Conviction Unit:

17 Section 15. The following named amounts, or so much of  
 18 those amounts, as may be necessary, respectively, for the  
 19 objects and purposes named, are appropriated to the Office  
 20 of the State Appellate Defender for expenses related to  
 21 federally assisted programs to work on systemic sentencing  
 22 issues appeals cases to which the agency is appointed:

1           Section 20. The following named amount of \$3,080,099, or  
2           so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from  
3           the Capital Litigation Trust Fund to the Office of the State  
4           Appellate Defender for expenses incurred in providing  
5           assistance to trial attorneys under item (c) (5) of Section  
6           10 of the State Appellate Defender Act.

7           Section 25. The following named amount, \$250,200, or so  
8           much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, is  
9           appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Office of  
10          the State Appellate Defender for the ordinary and contingent  
11          expenses of the Expungement Program.

12          Section 30. The following named amount, \$20,000, or so  
13          much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, is  
14          appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Office of  
15          the State Appellate Defender to provide statewide training to  
16          Public Defenders under the Public Defender Training Program.

17          Section 35. The following named amount, \$350,000, or so  
18          much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, is  
19          appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Office of  
20          the State Appellate Defender to develop a Juvenile Defender  
21          Resource Center.

1           Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
2    2008.
