Introduced 2/20/2008, by Sen. Gary G. Dahl

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

ILCON Art. XIII, Sec. 5

Proposes to amend the General Provisions Article of the Illinois Constitution. Provides that the pension benefits and rights for all executive branch and legislative branch constitutional officers and their employees shall be administered under a unified system enacted by law that provides the same rights and benefits for all members. Effective upon being declared adopted.

10	ARTICLE XIII
11	GENERAL PROVISIONS
12	(ILCON Art. XIII, Sec. 5)
13	SECTION 5. PENSION AND RETIREMENT RIGHTS
14	(a) Membership in any pension or retirement system of the
15	State, any unit of local government or school district, or any
16	agency or instrumentality thereof, shall be an enforceable
17	contractual relationship, the benefits of which shall not be
18	diminished or impaired.
19	(b) Notwithstanding subsection (a), after the effective
20	date of this subsection (b), the pension benefits and rights
21	for all executive branch and legislative branch constitutional
22	officers and their employees shall be administered under a

unified system enacted by law that provides the same rights and
