WHEREAS, Roosevelt Collins Jr. was born on April 15, 1947 in Norwood, Louisiana; his parents were Ira Mae Banks-Forman and Charlie Forman Sr.; Roosevelt Collins Jr. was baptized at an early age and became a member of Evergreen Baptist Church in Baton Rouge, Louisiana; and

WHEREAS, He graduated from Capital High in Baton Rouge, Louisiana in 1965; in 1969 he came to Chicago and began his career as a brick mason, and in 1972 became a member of the Bricklayers and Stone Masons Local 21 of Illinois; he enjoyed the art of laying bricks and stones for 34 years and he was known by other brick masons as one of the best in the business; during his career as a brick mason he crossed paths with several guys that he recognized as his buddies, Charlie, Vest and Mr. Hunter; and
