2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened to 3 learn of the death of James Richard Heil of Alton, who passed 4 away on June 15, 2007; and

5 WHEREAS, James Heil was born on February 18, 1935, in 6 Alton, the son of the late Harry J.R. and Luella Smith Heil; 7 and

8 WHEREAS, Mr. Heil served in the United States Army from 9 September of 1957 to March of 1958, and in the Reserves from 10 March of 1958 to December of 1963; he received a Bachelor of 11 Arts degree in 1957 and his Juris Doctor in 1961 from the 12 University of Illinois; he was licensed as an attorney by the 13 State of Illinois on October 26, 1961, and practiced law in the 14 Alton and Godfrey communities; and

WHEREAS, During his career he served as a Madison County 15 State's Attorney and as an Assistant Attorney General for the 16 State of Illinois; he was active in Republican politics, and 17 18 served on the Madison County Board from 1972 to 1982; he held a 19 Illinois Broker's License, taught real estate law at Lewis and Clark Community College, and received his certification of 20 21 master practitioner of neuro-linguistic programming in July of 22 1992; and
