SENATE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened to 3 learn of the death of Michael David Genczo of New Douglas, who 4 passed away on September 11, 2007; and

5 WHEREAS, Michael Genczo was born on March 22, 1916, in 6 Livingston, the son of the late John and Elizabeth Hoso Genczo; 7 he married Lucille Mosser on June 21, 1941, at St. Michael's 8 Catholic Church in Staunton and she preceded him in death; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Genczo was the track superintendent at Cahokia 10 Downs Race Track in East St. Louis for over 30 years; he was 11 also a self-employed farmer; and

12 WHEREAS, He was a veteran of the United States Army, 13 serving during World War II as a Staff Sergeant; he was a 14 member of St. Michael's Catholic Church in Staunton, a past 15 member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Livingston, and a 16 member of Laborer's Local 100 in East St. Louis; he was also a 17 card-carrying Democrat; and
