WHEREAS, Mr. DiGiovine was co-founder and principal of DiGiovine Hnilo + Johnson Ltd. and DiGiovine Hnilo Jordan + Johnson Financial Advisors Ltd. in Naperville; he was a Certified Public Accountant, Certified Financial Planner, and designated Certified Senior Advisor; and

WHEREAS, Mr. DiGiovine was the Past Treasurer and Board Member of the Naperville Noon Lions, Past Board Member of the Naperville Jaycees and SS. Peter and Paul Catholic Church Parish Council, a Charter Member of the Naperville Education Foundation, Past member of the Community Unit School District 203 Financial Task Force, Board Member and Finance Committee member of St. Patrick's Residence for the Aged and Infirm, and Past Board Member and Charter Member of the Naperville Rotary Sunrise Club; and
