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SENATE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, Farmers' markets provide not only a valuable 3 marketplace for farmers to sell their products directly to 4 consumers, but also a place for consumers to access fresh 5 fruits, vegetables, and other agricultural products; and

6 WHEREAS, These markets successfully operate across 7 Illinois; however, there is a lack of comprehensive regulation 8 from one county to the next, resulting in discrepancies between 9 counties regarding the products that may be sold; and

10 WHEREAS, In 1999, the Department of Public Health published 11 "Technical Information Bulletin/Food #30," in order to outline 12 the sanitation guidelines required for farmers' markets, 13 producer markets, and other outdoor food sales events; and

14 WHEREAS, This bulletin has not been uniformly interpreted 15 across the State; therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-FIFTH GENERAL 17 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that there is created the 18 Task Force on Farmers' Markets, consisting of 12 members 19 appointed as follows: the President of the Senate and Minority 20 Leader of the Senate shall each appoint one member to serve as 21 a co-chair; the Director of Public Health or his or her

SR0626 -2-LRB095 20649 RPM 48874 r 1 designee, the Director of Agriculture or his or her designee, a 2 representative of the Farm Bureau, 3 representatives of local 3 county public health departments appointed by the Director of Public Health and selected from 3 different counties 4 5 representing each of the northern, central, and southern portions of Illinois, and 4 members of the general public who 6 are engaged in local farmers' markets, 2 of whom shall each be 7 8 approved by a co-chair of the Task Force; and be it further

9 RESOLVED, That all members of the Task Force shall serve
10 without compensation; and be it further

11 RESOLVED, That the Task Force can appoint members as it 12 sees fit to serve as representatives of local farmers' markets 13 or other concerned parties; and be it further

14 RESOLVED, That the duty of the Task Force is to undertake a 15 thorough comprehensive and review of the current implementation of the various Acts that define which products 16 17 and practices are permitted and which products and practices are not permitted at farmers' markets and other outdoor food 18 sale events; and be it further 19

20 RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall assist the Department 21 of Public Health in developing interagency agreements and 22 programs and procedures regarding the implementation of the SR0626 -3- LRB095 20649 RPM 48874 r various Acts that define which products and practices are permitted and which products and practices are not permitted at farmers' markets and other outdoor food sale events; and be it further

5 RESOLVED, That the Illinois Department of Public Health 6 shall provide staffing support to the Task Force and shall 7 administer and prepare all reports deemed necessary in 8 conjunction with the Task Force; and be it further

9 RESOLVED, That the Task Force may request assistance from 10 any entity necessary or useful for the performance of its 11 duties; and be it further

12 RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall issue a report with its 13 recommendations to the Senate on or before December 31, 2008.
