WHEREAS, She was a longtime member of the Downers Grove Oratorio Society, having the distinction of performing under the direction of baritone Sherrill Milnes; she was a passionate volunteer and gave her time to Hinsdale Hospital since 1972, making children smile in the pediatric department as well as
