Malloy had a long and distinguished career in law enforcement; he began his career in 1983 as a reserve officer for the Bolingbrook Police Department; he became a full-time officer in 1987; he quickly rose through the ranks, becoming sergeant in 1999 and lieutenant in 2002; in 2003, he was promoted once more to the position of assistant police chief, serving there until his retirement in August of 2007; and
