SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/12-610.1

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that a person, regardless of age, may not use a wireless telephone in a school speed zone or a construction or maintenance speed zone, except for a person engaged in a highway construction or maintenance project for which a construction or maintenance speed zone has been established when the person is using a wireless telephone in furtherance of that project.

AN ACT concerning transportation.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
Section 12-610.1 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/12-610.1)

7 Sec. 12-610.1. Wireless telephones.

8 (a) As used in this Section, "wireless telephone" means a 9 device that is capable of transmitting or receiving telephonic 10 communications without a wire connecting the device to the 11 telephone network.

(b) A person under the age of 19 years who holds an instruction permit issued under Section 6-105 or 6-107.1, or a person under the age of 19 years who holds a graduated license issued under Section 6-107, may not drive a vehicle on a roadway while using a wireless phone.

(c) This Section does not apply to a person under the age of 19 years using a wireless telephone for emergency purposes, including, but not limited to, an emergency call to a law enforcement agency, health care provider, fire department, or other emergency services agency or entity.

(d) If a graduated driver's license holder over the age of
18 committed an offense against traffic regulations governing

1 the movement of vehicles or any violation of Section 6-107 or 2 Section 12-603.1 of this Code in the 6 months prior to the 3 graduated driver's license holder's 18th birthday, and was 4 subsequently convicted of the violation, the provisions of 5 paragraph (b) shall continue to apply until such time as a 6 period of 6 consecutive months has elapsed without an additional violation and subsequent conviction of an offense 7 8 against traffic regulations governing the movement of vehicles 9 or any violation of Section 6-107 or Section 12-603.1 of this 10 Code.

11 (e) A person, regardless of age, may not use a wireless 12 telephone while operating a motor vehicle in a school speed 13 zone established under Section 11-605 or a construction or 14 maintenance speed zone established under Section 11-605.1. This subsection (e) does not apply to a person engaged in a 15 16 highway construction or maintenance project for which a 17 construction or maintenance speed zone has been established under Section 11-605.1 when the person is using a wireless 18 19 telephone in furtherance of that project.
