1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 271

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 271 on page 5, by
3 replacing lines 13 through 17 with the following:

4 "witness, respectively, unless the conduct that gave rise to
5 the action was willful or wanton misconduct."; and

6 on page 7, line 1, by changing "United States citizen" to
7 "citizen or legal permanent resident of the United States"; and

8 on page 7, line 2, by replacing "a felony." with the following:

9 "forgery, embezzlement, obtaining money under false pretenses,
10 larceny, extortion, conspiracy to defraud, or any other similar
11 offense, or a felony involving moral turpitude, in any court of
12 competent jurisdiction in this State or any other state,
13 district, or territory of the United States or of a foreign
14 country, unless the Board waives this qualification after
15 taking into account the nature of the applicant's conduct, any
16 aggravating or extenuating circumstances, the time elapsed

1 since the conviction, the rehabilitation or restitution
2 performed by the applicant, and any other factors that the
3 Board deems relevant.".
