9 "Department" means the Department of State Police.

10 "Director" means the Director of State Police.

"Missing endangered senior" means an individual 65 years of age or older <u>or a person with Alzheimer's disease or related</u> <u>dementias</u> who is reported missing to a law enforcement agency and is, or is believed to be:

(1) a temporary or permanent resident of Illinois;
(2) at a location that cannot be determined by an
individual familiar with the missing individual; and

18 (3) incapable of returning to the individual's 19 residence without assistance.
