Sec. 1. In each public school classroom, the teacher in charge <u>may conduct</u> shall observe a brief period of silence with the participation of all the pupils therein assembled at the opening of every school day. This period shall not be conducted as a religious exercise but shall be an opportunity for silent prayer or for <u>such</u> silent reflection <u>as may be desired by each</u> <u>individual pupil</u> on the anticipated activities of the day.
