

1 AN ACT concerning local government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Township Code is amended by adding Section
5 15-70 as follows:

6 (60 ILCS 1/15-70 new)

7 Sec. 15-70. City council meetings; township business. The
8 city council of any coterminous city located in a county with a
9 population of less than 1,000,000 may, by the affirmative vote
10 of three-fourths of its members, authorize the township
11 supervisor to preside over portions of city council meetings
12 when the city council is exercising powers that would
13 ordinarily be exercised by the township board in a township not
14 organized under this Article. While the township supervisor is
15 presiding, the supervisor has one vote and the mayor has no
16 vote.

17 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
18 becoming law.
