A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT making appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The amount of \$25,000,000, or so much of that
5 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
6 Revenue Fund to the Department of Commerce and Economic
7 Opportunity for all costs and expenses associated with the
8 Employer Training Investment Program (ETIP) pursuant to,
9 without limitation, Sections 605-800 and 605-802 of the
10 Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity Law of the
11 Civil Administrative Code of Illinois (20 ILCS 605/605-800
12 and 605-802).

13 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
14 2009.
