SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 405/405-335 new

Amends the Department of Central Management Services Law. Requires the Department to establish and maintain a website known as the Illinois Accountability Portal. The website shall provide direct access to information concerning State employees and individual consultants, State expenditures, State tax credits, State contracts, revocations and suspensions of occupation and use tax certificates of registration and professional licenses, recipients and uses of appropriations initiated by or on behalf of General Assembly members, and recipients and uses of the Governor's lump sum appropriations. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning State government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Department of Central Management Services

 Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by

 adding Section 405-335 as follows:
- 7 (20 ILCS 405/405-335 new)
- 8 Sec. 405-335. Illinois Accountability Portal. To establish
- 9 and maintain a website, known as the Illinois Accountability
- 10 Portal, with a full-time webmaster. The website shall provide
- 11 direct access to each of the following:
- 12 (1) A database of all current State employees and
- individual consultants, sorted separately by name, agency, and
- 14 position title, listing for each their current pay rate and
- 15 <u>year-to-date pay.</u>
- 16 (2) A database of all current State expenditures, sorted
- separately by agency, category, customer, and Representative
- 18 District.
- 19 <u>(3)</u> A database of all current State tax credits, sorted
- 20 separately by tax credit category, customer, and
- 21 Representative District.
- 22 (4) A database of all revocations and suspensions of State
- 23 occupation and use tax certificates of registration and all

1	revocations	and	suspensions	of	State	professional	licenses,	,
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- 2 sorted separately by name, geographic location, and
- 3 certificate of registration number or license number, as
- 4 applicable. Professional license revocations and suspensions
- 5 <u>shall be posted only if resulting from a failure to pay taxes,</u>
- 6 license fees, or child support.
- 7 (5) A database of all current State contracts, sorted
- 8 separately by contractor name, awarding officer or agency,
- 9 <u>contract value</u>, and goods or services provided.
- 10 (6) A database of the recipients of appropriations
- initiated by or on behalf of members of the General Assembly
- and the amounts and uses of the appropriations.
- 13 (7) A database of the recipients of any portions of lump
- sum appropriations to the Governor and the amounts and uses of
- 15 those portions.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 17 becoming law.
