- 10 <u>(a) Subject to appropriation, the Department must develop a</u>

- Department for a grant to be awarded to a local development
- organization in that county or municipality for the purpose of
- 15 <u>fostering local or regional economic development. A local</u>
- 16 <u>development organization is not eliqible to receive grant</u>
- 17 <u>moneys under this Section if it has publicly endorsed any</u>
- 18 political candidate or if it distributes political
- 19 <u>questionnaires. Organizations receiving funds under this</u>
- Section may be required to submit to audits by the Department.
- 21 <u>Documents produced under the grant program are subject to the</u>
