2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

January 1 and shall expire on December 31 or on another date that may be selected by the Secretary; registrations of apportionable vehicles and pedalcycles, however, shall commence on the first day of April and shall expire March 31 of the following calendar year;

When registered on a 2 calendar year basis 7 commencing January 1 of an even-numbered year, expiration 8 shall be on the 31st day of December of the ensuing 9 odd-numbered year, or at such other later date as may be 10 selected in the discretion of the Secretary of State not 11 beyond March 1 next;

3. When registered on a fiscal year basis commencing July 1, expiration shall be on the 30th day of June or at such other later date as may be selected in the discretion of the Secretary of State not beyond September 1 next;

4. When registered on a 2 fiscal year basis commencing
July 1 of an even-numbered year, expiration shall be on the
30th day of June of the ensuing even-numbered year, or at
such other later date as may be selected in the discretion
of the Secretary of State not beyond September 1 next;

5. (b) Vehicle registrations of vehicles of the first division
 shall be for a calendar year, or 2 calendar year, or 3 calendar
 <u>year</u> basis as provided for in this Chapter.

Vehicle registrations of vehicles under Sections 3-807,
3-808 and 3-809 shall be on an indefinite term basis or a 2
calendar year basis as provided for in this Chapter.

7 Vehicle registrations for vehicles of the second division
8 shall be for a fiscal year, 2 fiscal year or calendar year
9 basis as provided for in this Chapter.

10 Motor vehicles registered under the provisions of Section 11 Sections 3-402.1 and 3-405.3 shall be issued multi-year 12 registration plates with a new registration card issued 13 annually upon payment of the appropriate fees. Motor vehicles 14 registered under the provisions of Section 3-405.3 shall be issued mutli-year registration plates with a new multi-year 15 16 registration card issued pursuant to subsections (j) and (k) of 17 this Section upon payment of the appropriate fees. 18 Apportionable trailers and apportionable semitrailers 19 registered under the provisions of Section 3-402.1 shall be 20 issued multi-year registration plates and cards that will be subject to revocation for failure to pay annual fees required 21 22 by Section 3-814.1. The Secretary shall determine when these 23 vehicles shall be issued new registration plates.

(c) Every vehicle registration specified in Section 3-810
 and every registration card and registration plate or
 registration sticker issued thereunder shall expire on the 31st

day of December of each year or at such other date as may be
 selected in the discretion of the Secretary of State.

(d) Every vehicle registration for a vehicle of the second 3 division weighing over 8,000 pounds, except as provided in 4 5 paragraph (g) of this Section, and every registration card and registration plate or registration sticker, where applicable, 6 7 issued hereunder to such vehicles shall be issued for a fiscal 8 year commencing on July 1st of each registration year. However, 9 the Secretary of State may, pursuant to an agreement or 10 arrangement or declaration providing for apportionment of a 11 fleet of vehicles with other jurisdictions, provide for 12 registration of such vehicles under apportionment or for all of 13 the vehicles registered in Illinois by an applicant who 14 registers some of his vehicles under apportionment on a 15 calendar year basis instead, and the fees or taxes to be paid 16 on a calendar year basis shall be identical to those specified 17 in this Act for a fiscal year registration. Provision for 18 installment payment may also be made.

(e) Semitrailer registrations under apportionment may be on a calendar year under a reciprocal agreement or arrangement and all other semitrailer registrations shall be on fiscal year or 2 fiscal year or 4 fiscal year basis as provided for in this Chapter.

(f) The Secretary of State may convert annual registration
 plates or 2-year registration plates, whether registered on a
 calendar year or fiscal year basis, to multi-year plates. The

1 determination of which plate categories and when to convert to 2 multi-year plates is solely within the discretion of the 3 Secretary of State.

(q) After January 1, 1975, each registration, registration 4 5 card and registration plate or registration sticker, where applicable, issued for a recreational vehicle or recreational 6 or camping trailer, except a house trailer, used exclusively by 7 8 the owner for recreational purposes, and not used commercially 9 nor as a truck or bus, nor for hire, shall be on a calendar year 10 basis; except that the Secretary of State shall provide for 11 registration and the issuance of registration cards and plates 12 or registration stickers, where applicable, for one 6-month period in order to accomplish an orderly transition from a 13 14 fiscal year to a calendar year basis. Fees and taxes due under 15 this Act for a registration year shall be appropriately reduced 16 for such 6-month transitional registration period.

17 (h) The Secretary of State may, in order to accomplish an orderly transition for vehicles registered under Section 18 19 3-402.1 of this Code from a calendar year registration to a 20 March 31st expiration, require applicants to pay fees and taxes due under this Code on a 15 month registration basis. However, 21 22 if in the discretion of the Secretary of State this creates an 23 undue hardship on any applicant the Secretary may allow the applicant to pay 3 month fees and taxes at the time of 24 25 registration and the additional 12 month fees and taxes to be 26 payable no later than March 31 of the year after this

2 (i) The Secretary of State may stagger registrations, or 3 change the annual expiration date, as necessary for the 4 convenience of the public and the efficiency of his Office. In 5 order to appropriately and effectively accomplish any such 6 staggering, the Secretary of State is authorized to prorate all required registration fees, rounded to the nearest dollar, but 7 8 in no event for a period longer than 18 months, at a monthly 9 rate for a 12 month registration fee.

10 (j) The Secretary of State may enter into an agreement with 11 a rental owner, as defined in Section 3-400 of this Code, who 12 registers a fleet of motor vehicles of the first division 13 pursuant to Section 3-405.3 of this Code to provide for the 14 registration of the rental owner's vehicles on a 2 or 3 calendar year basis and the issuance of multi-year registration 15 16 plates with a new registration card issued up to every 3 years. 17 (k) The Secretary of State may provide multi-year registration cards for any registered fleet of motor vehicles 18 19 of the first or second division that are registered pursuant to 20 Section 3-405.3 of this Code. (d) Two fiscal years.
