

## 96TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2009 and 2010 HB0873

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

65 ILCS 5/3.1-25-100 new 65 ILCS 5/6-4-7.5 new

Amends the Illinois Municipal Code. Provides that individual members of the board of trustees of certain villages may not hire a separate attorney using public funds unless the village attorney is disqualified from or recuses himself or herself from representing the member in his or her official capacity. Effective immediately.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by adding Sections 3.1-25-100 and 6-4-7.5 as follows:
- 6 (65 ILCS 5/3.1-25-100 new)
- Sec. 3.1-25-100. Village trustees; attorney. One or more
  individual members of the board of trustees of any village
  incorporated under this Division may not hire a separate
  attorney using public funds unless the village attorney is
  disqualified from or recuses himself or herself from
- representing the member in his or her official capacity.
- 13 (65 ILCS 5/6-4-7.5 new)
- Sec. 6-4-7.5. Village trustees; attorney. One or more individual members of the board of trustees of any village incorporated under this Division may not hire a separate attorney using public funds unless the village attorney is disqualified from or recuses himself or herself from
- representing the member in his or her official capacity.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
