1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 1683

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 1683 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The University of Illinois Act is amended by
5 adding Section 45 as follows:

6 (110 ILCS 305/45 new)

7 Sec. 45. Property right in education; due process. Students
8 of the University shall have a property right in their
9 education. If a student is suspended or expelled by the
10 University, the University must comply with the due process
11 provisions of the United States and Illinois Constitutions.

12 Section 10. The Southern Illinois University Management
13 Act is amended by adding Section 30 as follows:

14 (110 ILCS 520/30 new)

1 Sec. 30. Property right in education; due process. Students
2 of the University shall have a property right in their
3 education. If a student is suspended or expelled by the
4 University, the University must comply with the due process
5 provisions of the United States and Illinois Constitutions.

6 Section 15. The Chicago State University Law is amended by
7 adding Section 5-140 as follows:

8 (110 ILCS 660/5-140 new)

9 Sec. 5-140. Property right in education; due process.
10 Students of the University shall have a property right in their
11 education. If a student is suspended or expelled by the
12 University, the University must comply with the due process
13 provisions of the United States and Illinois Constitutions.

14 Section 20. The Eastern Illinois University Law is amended
15 by adding Section 10-140 as follows:

16 (110 ILCS 665/10-140 new)

17 Sec. 10-140. Property right in education; due process.
18 Students of the University shall have a property right in their
19 education. If a student is suspended or expelled by the
20 University, the University must comply with the due process
21 provisions of the United States and Illinois Constitutions.

1 Section 25. The Governors State University Law is amended
2 by adding Section 15-140 as follows:

3 (110 ILCS 670/15-140 new)

4 Sec. 15-140. Property right in education; due process.
5 Students of the University shall have a property right in their
6 education. If a student is suspended or expelled by the
7 University, the University must comply with the due process
8 provisions of the United States and Illinois Constitutions.

9 Section 30. The Illinois State University Law is amended by
10 adding Section 20-145 as follows:

11 (110 ILCS 675/20-145 new)

12 Sec. 20-145. Property right in education; due process.
13 Students of the University shall have a property right in their
14 education. If a student is suspended or expelled by the
15 University, the University must comply with the due process
16 provisions of the United States and Illinois Constitutions.

17 Section 35. The Northeastern Illinois University Law is
18 amended by adding Section 25-140 as follows:

19 (110 ILCS 680/25-140 new)

20 Sec. 25-140. Property right in education; due process.
21 Students of the University shall have a property right in their

1 education. If a student is suspended or expelled by the
2 University, the University must comply with the due process
3 provisions of the United States and Illinois Constitutions.

4 Section 40. The Northern Illinois University Law is amended
5 by adding Section 30-150 as follows:

6 (110 ILCS 685/30-150 new)

7 Sec. 30-150. Property right in education; due process.
8 Students of the University shall have a property right in their
9 education. If a student is suspended or expelled by the
10 University, the University must comply with the due process
11 provisions of the United States and Illinois Constitutions.

12 Section 45. The Western Illinois University Law is amended
13 by adding Section 35-145 as follows:

14 (110 ILCS 690/35-145 new)

15 Sec. 35-145. Property right in education; due process.
16 Students of the University shall have a property right in their
17 education. If a student is suspended or expelled by the
18 University, the University must comply with the due process
19 provisions of the United States and Illinois Constitutions.

20 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
21 becoming law."
