2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 2129 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following amounts, or so much of those
6 amounts as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
7 and purposes named, are appropriated to the Illinois State
8 Board of Education for the fiscal year beginning July 1,
9 2009:

1 Section 10. In addition to any other amounts appropriated

 5 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009, pursuant to Title
 6 XIV (Education) of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act
 7 of 2009:

9 Section 15. In addition to any other amounts appropriated
 10 for such purposes, the following named amounts, or so much
 11 thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated from the
 12 General Revenue Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education
 13 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009, pursuant to Title
 14 XIV (Other Government Services) of the American Recovery and
 15 Reinvestment Act of 2009:

17 Section 20. The following amounts, or so much thereof as
 18 may be necessary, which shall be used by the Illinois State
 19 Board of Education exclusively for the foregoing purposes and
 20 not, under any circumstances, for personal services
 21 expenditures or other operational or administrative costs,
 22 are appropriated to the Illinois State Board of Education for
