

## 96TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2009 and 2010 HB2238

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

215 ILCS 5/143.19c new

Amends the Illinois Insurance Code. Provides that no policy of automobile insurance may be cancelled where the basis for such cancellation is the insured's lack of a valid drivers license or valid instruction permit if the insurer failed to ask the insured for proof of a valid drivers license or valid instruction permit at the time the insured applied for coverage.

- 7 Sec. 143.19c. No policy of insurance as defined in
- 8 subsection a. of Section 143.13 of this Act may be cancelled
- 9 where the basis for such cancellation is the insured's lack of
- 10 a valid drivers license or valid instruction permit if the
- insurer failed to ask the insured for proof of a valid drivers
- 12 license or valid instruction permit at the time the insured
- applied for coverage.
